We had an absolute ball at the school concert this week. A huge thank you to everyone involved - it was certainly a day to remember!



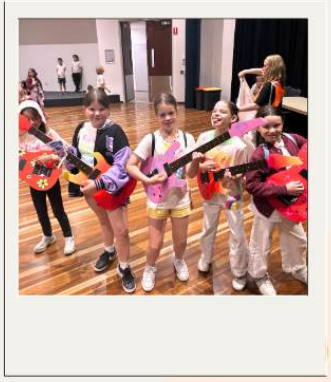

Students in the Year 3 to 6 area have been learning how to play downball, hockey and rounders.



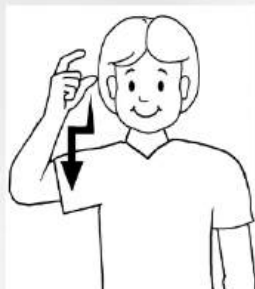
