# **BACK TO SCHOOL IN METRO MELBOURNE**

Dear Reservoir Views students, families and local community members,

Monday marks an important step towards having all of our students back learning face-to-face at school and I, along with everyone else, can't wait.

For our Foundation students resuming three days a week on Monday and year 1 and 2 students returning two days a week on Thursday it will have been 94 and 97 days since they have been on-site with all of their classmates and their teacher learning. 94 and 97 days of not being able to connect with their peers and teacher as they normally would, not being able to play inside or outside the classroom, not being able to attend Art, Music and PE specialist classes and not being able to learn within their normal classroom environment.

Our students, like all students who have endured lockdowns and remote learning across the globe, have endured so much and missed so much, we cannot wait to resume some sort of normality.

#### SCHOOL DROP OFF and PICK UP

Unfortunately, there are access restrictions still in place and families are not able to enter the school with their children at this stage.

Staff supervision in the yard commences at 8:45am and this is the time we will be opening two access gates to the school. The main entry gate on Hickford St and the St Vigeons Rd gate will be used for pick up and drop off.

Once the gates are opened at 8:45am, staff will assist students to sanitise their hands and be there to support them to their classrooms if required. We will have 'all hands on deck' to support students transitioning back to school.

Staff will also supervise and support the pick up of students at 3:30pm. Can I please ask all families to let children know what gate they will be picked up from. This will assist staff supervising students to these gates prior to 3:30pm dismissal.

Can I also please ask all families to practise physical distancing throughout these times.

#### **VISITING THE OFFICE**

If you need to visit the office, please use the QR code at the gate prior to entry and please ensure you are wearing a face mask. There is a density limit of 2 visitors in the office area at any time.

#### **OUT OF SCHOOL HOURS CARE**

The Out of School Hours Care program that is operated by Camp Australia is still operating from 7am to 8:45am and from 3:30pm to 6pm.

#### **FACE MASKS**

While face masks for students in Foundation to year 2 are not mandatory, they are recommended for all students attending school.

The wearing of face masks indoors while at school has been **mandated for all students in years 3 to 6**. I am expecting to receive further information from DET regarding this and I will forward this to the community once I receive it.

#### **DRINK BOTTLES**

A reminder for all students to please bring their drink bottles to school.

#### HATS AND SUNSCREEN

It is Term 4 and the UV levels are already quite high. All students need to bring their 'sunsmart' hats back to school. I also encourage students to apply sunscreen prior to arriving at school and have their own small sized bottle/tube of sunscreen to reapply prior to break times.

#### **CANTEEN**

The school canteen will be open as 'normal' beginning next week.

#### WHOLE SCHOOL SWIMMING PROGRAM

Unfortunately due to the current restrictions and date of booking, our term 4 swimming program will not take place this year.

#### **FOUNDATION ORIENTATION PROGRAM**


