Dear Reservoir Views students, families and local community members,

STAGGERED SCHOOL START AND FINISH TIMES

All school entry gates will be closed until 8:30am (access for before and after school care will still be available via the main entrance on Hickford St). From 8:30am gates will be unlocked and staff will be positioned at these gates to support students entering school grounds.

NEW FINISH TIMES. These times will be in place for the remainder of Term 2.

- -Foundation students (and any of their siblings in Years 1 or 2) will now finish school at 2:50pm.
- **-Year 1 and 2** students will now finish school at 3.10pm.
- -Year 3 and 4 students will now finish school at 3.20pm.
- -Year 5 and 6 students will finish school at 3.30pm.

All three entry gates (St Vigeons, Hickford St main entrance and Hickford St crossing entrance) to the school will be staffed from these pick up times.

All older siblings are to leave at the younger siblings finish time.

If you have a child starting Foundation next year or know someone who will be enrolling with us, this is a reminder to book in for a school tour, and collect an enrolment form from the office.


SCHOOL PHOTOS
