

Last year our school undertook a rigorous school review of our 2016-2019 School Strategic Plan. Clara holds a Masters degree in Psychology. She is a passionate psychologist who works with both children and adolescents who are experiencing a range of psychological issues such as anxiety and mood disorders, Autism Spectrum Disorders, interpersonal, learning and behavioural disorders, exam stress, self-harming and adjustment difficulties (social & situational). Clara employs psychological techniques such as Cognitive Behavioural Therapy, client-centred and solution-focused therapy with psycho-education. Clara firmly believes that a collaborative approach will produce the most successful outcomes for a child.
