WHOLE SCHOOL HOUSE ATHLETICS DAY— FRIDAY the 6th of MARCH

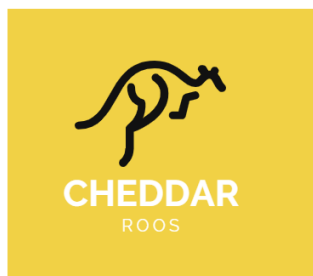
Next Friday the 6th we will be celebrating our 2nd annual House Athletics day here at Reservoir Views.

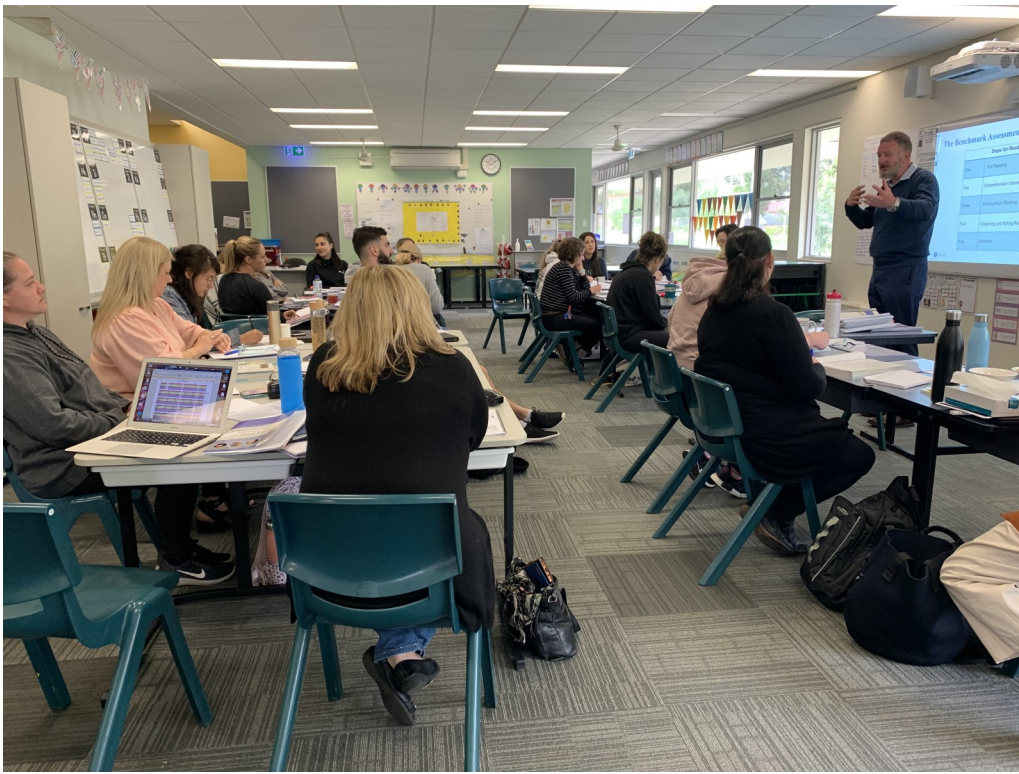
2021 FOUNDATION ENROLMENTS AND SCHOOL TOURS

Services are performed at NO COST to the school, student or parent and is covered through Medicare bulk billing. We are now lucky to have OnPsych at our school. The OnPsych staff member who is working at our school is **Clara Lee**.

Clara holds a Masters degree in Psychology. She is a passionate psychologist who works with both children and adolescents who are experiencing a range of psychological issues such as anxiety and mood disorders, Autism Spectrum Disorders, interpersonal, learning and behavioural disorders, exam stress, self-harming and adjustment difficulties (social & situational). Clara employs psychological techniques such as Cognitive Behavioural Therapy, client-centred and solution-focused therapy with psycho-education. Clara firmly believes that a collaborative approach will produce the most successful outcomes for a child.
