#### Toilets

- Many toilet breaks and reminders in the first few weeks!

#### Learning at Reservoir Views

- Literacy and Maths Phonological Awareness, Phonics, Reading,
   Writing and Maths sessions happen daily.
- **Inquiry** -Science and Humanities are explored weekly through Inquiry. Each topic begins with an engaging shared experienced, and is then driven by student questions and wonderings.
- SEL SEL is our Social and Emotional Learning program. It incorporates aspects of The Zones of Regulation, Respectful Relationships, and other wellbeing learning linked to the Victorian Curriculum.
- Wellbeing catering for each individual child.





#### Individual Education Plans

- IEPs Every student is given an IEP (Individual Education Plan). This will contain their own personal, targeted goal for Literacy and Maths, along with a personal and social goal.
- Your child's IEP will also provide you with information on what the child, family and teacher can do to help support your child to achieve these goals.
- Your child receives a copy of their goals to refer to, reinforced with visuals.



## Student-led Individual Education Plan Meetings

- Student-led Individual Education Plan meetings are held at the end of each term.
- These meetings actively involves parents/carers, student and teachers in reflecting on and celebrating student progress against goals within the Individual Education Plans and setting future learning goals.







#### Staying connected.

## Who will my child's teacher be?

- Grade lists will be finalised in Term 4.

#### Reporting to parents

- We have an open door policy and you are more than welcome to discuss any concerns or ask any questions you may have!
- We are usually available before and after school if you need to ask a quick question or we can always make time for a more formal meeting if necessary.
- Reports will be available at the end of Semester 1 (Term 2) and at the end of the school year (Term 4).
- Student led IEP meetings happen on the last 2 days of each term, this is a chance for students to celebrate their learning, check in with their goals and set new ones for the following term. Families will receive a copy of these goals each term.
