Dear Reservoir Views students, families and local community members,

Earlier this week I received the wonderful news that Reservoir Views Primary School was successful in applying for the 2019 / 2020 Octopus School Program funding through Darebin City Council.

The program aims to create a safe school precinct that encourages students and families to choose active modes of transport such as walking, cycling and scooting.

As the selected school for this year's program, we will receive over \$150,000 investment in the school precinct, which includes up to \$50,000 to support active travel programs guided by Council in the 2019/20 financial year. This is a great opportunity for our school and community.

I'd like to thank Drew and Candice for helping write the application. We will be meeting with representatives from Darebin City Council next week to plan for 2020. The *Octopus School Program* was piloted in 2017/18 with Reservoir West Primary School the first Octopus School. Newlands Primary School was selected as the second Octopus School for 2018/19. We are thrilled to be the third Octopus School within the City of Darebin!



SUPERVISED SCHOOL CROSSING AREAS.

I have felt a great sense of sadness following the tragic incident that happened in Epping earlier this week. It really reinforces the need to be incredibly conscious anywhere around motor vehicles.

We are very fortunate at Reservoir Views to have two very competent school crossing supervisors at our two signed and supervised crossing areas on Hickford St and St Vigeons Rd during peak drop off and pick up times. Safety for our children/students and ourselves has to be priority when crossing these roads. I have been alarmed at the number of parents ignoring these crossings and choosing to cross both of these roads with their children. At worse, it may add another two minutes to your trip home by using the supervised crossing areas, to help our students stay safe and learn road safety skills, please use them.
