Dear Reservoir Views students, families and local community members,

It has been just wonderful having seen all classes spend part of this week learning on-site and it will be even better when all students return for full-time on-site learning on Wednesday the 3rd of November.

With the new changes coming at 6pm tomorrow night, there will be significant changes to guidelines/procedures at Reservoir Views.

ENTRY TO SCHOOL GROUNDS

Commencing on Wednesday the 3rd of November, parents, guardians and caregivers are **now** allowed to enter school grounds for drop off and pick up. Access to school buildings is still restricted unless you are visiting the main office.

You are not required to check in using the QR code unless you are visiting the office.

We will be opening all school gates at 8:30am each morning for entry for students who are supervised by an adult.

I would like to remind everyone that there is no staff supervision before 8:45am within school grounds, please access the Out of School Hours Service if required.

All gates will be opened at 3:15pm each day.

Can I please ask everyone to practice safe physical distancing during these times.

FACE MASKS

School staff are now not required to wear face masks outdoors. Students in years 3 and above are still required to wear face masks indoors and the Chief Health Officer recommends students in years prep to grade 2 to wear face masks indoors while at school.

SCHOOL TOURS / KINDERGARTEN TO PREP TRANSITION / GRADE 6 GRADUATION / STATEWIDE YEAR 6 to 7 TRANSITION DAY

School tours can now recommence, our kindergarten to prep orientation program can now take place on-site and we can now plan for a special grade 6 graduation celebration. The statewide year 6 to 7 transition day scheduled for Tuesday the 7th of December can now take place as planned.

OUTDOOR LEARNING SHADE SAIL GRANT

I successfully applied for a \$25,000 grant to create an outdoor shaded learning space. I have requested quotes from various companies to install the shade structures and there are two proposed spaces for this space.



My preferred space would be the 'rock garden' area to the west of building C. This space will be an outdoor learning area for all students to be able to access during class time and a space for students during play times. It would also mean removing the 'rock garden' and installing outdoor seating and tables.

DRINK BOTTLES

A reminder for all students to please bring their drink bottles to school.

HATS AND SUNSCREEN

It is Term 4 and the UV levels are already quite high. All students need to bring their 'sunsmart' hats back to school. I also encourage students to apply sunscreen prior to arriving at school and have their own small sized bottle/tube of sunscreen to reapply prior to break times.


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




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A message from your Coordinator Nebal


This week children will enjoy Rainbow Volcano Science Experiment and 3D Paper Rainbow Craft.
