> Chopping up the COMPOST before it's put in the bins


> ALWAYS COVER THE COMPOST!!!


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On the 28th of November RVPS JSC will be hosting its annual fun run.

Money raised will go towards the resurfacing of the school oval that is in desperate need of repair.








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CHRISTMAS RAFFLE
