Dear Reservoir Views Students, Parents and Community members,

Next week teachers will be planning throughout the week in preparation for Term 4. This is where teachers come together for the day as a cohort team to look at student learning, data and the curriculum to create the teaching and learning that will take place throughout the term. This is also a chance for teachers to be reflective about the teaching and learning that has been happening to ensure that student needs are being met.



Teachers have been working closely with the students in developing Writing goals at the point of need for each individual student. This allows for students to have agency in their learning. They know what they are able to do, they know what their next goal is and how to achieve it. Students will then have a conference with their teacher to discuss how they are going and discuss their success. Have a chat with your child/ren about their writing goal and how they are going with achieving it.
