I can't thank Uncle Brendan enough for working with us over the last four weeks, it has been such an uplifting experience.



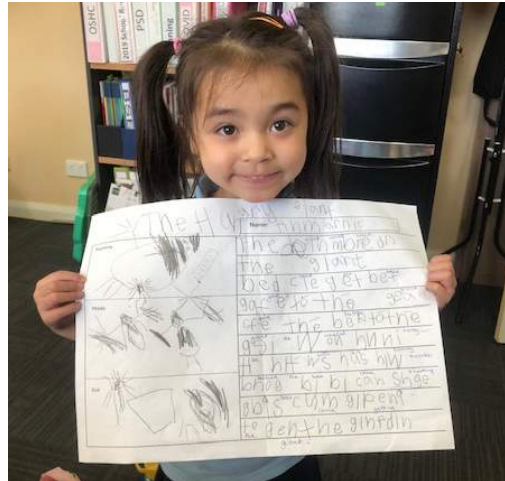




We will officially launch this beautiful addition to our school during next year's welcome picnic early in Term 1.

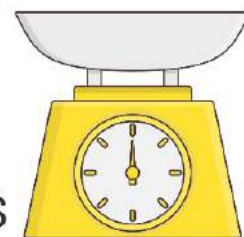


## WRITING

We have been practising writing persuasive texts. Students have learnt that they need to persuade the reader and use strong language.

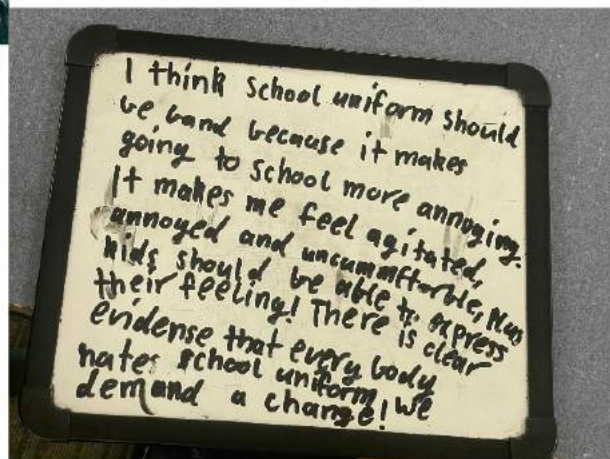

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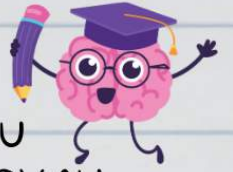

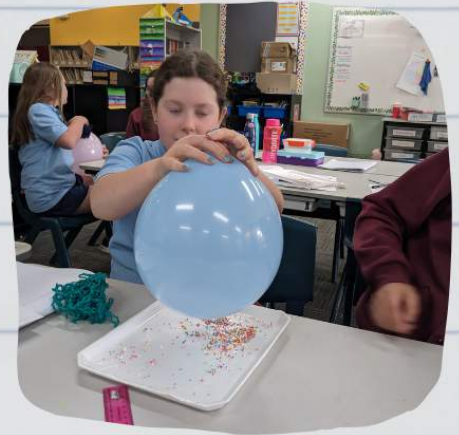

## STATIC ELECTRICITY

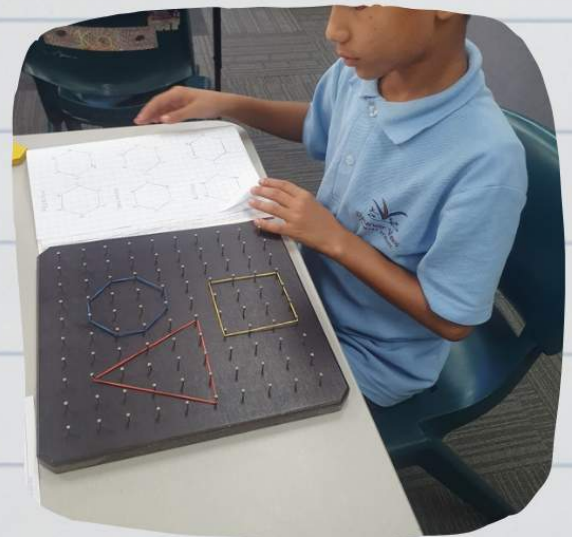
